### **Artist Bio**

Fruma Markowitz was formally trained in photography and fine arts at the Bezalel Academy of Art and Design in Jerusalem, Israel, where she graduated with a BFA in Photography in 1984. For the next five years she worked as a photojournalist, book jacket designer, portraitist and fashion photographer, as well as exhibiting her personal work in several group exhibitions in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem.

In 1988 Fruma discovered the creative possibilities for using computers in both her commercial and creative work, and consequently earned an MPS from New York University's Interactive Telecommunications department. For the past 25 years she has had a "day job" as a user experience strategist and designer of numerous web sites, mobile apps, and software products across a variety of industries.

Since moving to CT in 2003 Fruma's photography practice has functioned as her personal visual diary. She makes images daily and shows her work at both local and national fine art venues, all while commuting to work in NYC and raising a family. During the COVID-19 pandemic her practice pivoted towards engagement with historic and alternative photographic processes. Concern with women's and environmental issues are consistent themes in her work.
